Object: Monkey teeth necklace (or armlet)

Material: Monkey teeth, woven cotton, string

Description: A *ochoker*-type necklace (or an armlet) made of off-white woven cotton, embellished with two rows of monkey teeth, pierced and sewn to the cotton base. Approximately half of the object is augmented by seven strands of twisted cotton string, locked by making a knot on all ends of the strands.
