	Description: The broad leaf of the Sansevieria plant (Liliaceae) called Kirku-mkonge, is broken apart and the fibres are pulled out a few at a time and rolled between the palms. More fibres are added to form a con-

tinuous string and then plaited to form a flat rope, Neg. No. tapered to nothing at one end. New rope wound into a ball is purchased from the market. Nearly white.
