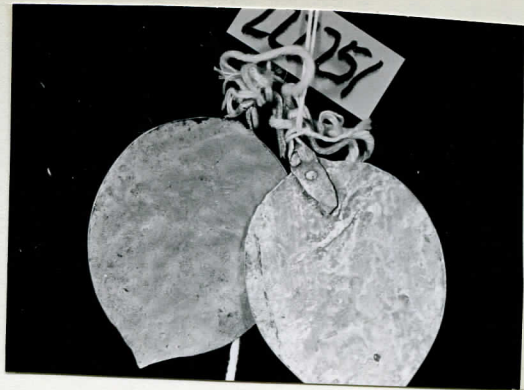
Object: Earrings (Akaparar-sing. Mkakaparar- pl.)
