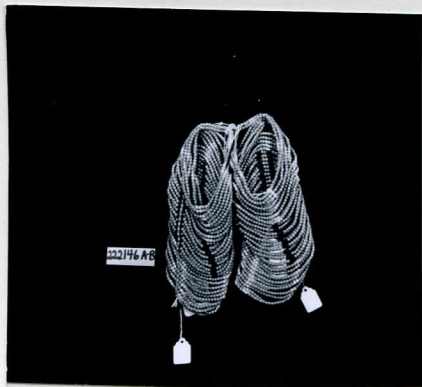
Object: Pair of anklets (Mutukoa)

Material: Beads, boobab fibre

Description: Thirty three-strand anklets made of very old opaque glass beads, woven together with boobab fibre string (muamba) in four places. Beads are 3 mm. in orange, green, yellow, and blue in geometric block designs. Beads are bought by a husband to show esteem. Worn rarely today.
