**Description:** New doll made for the tourist trade in a craft shop. Doll is a stylized figure made from a single block of wood and painted black. Female. Costume is correct for a married woman. Multicolored beaded aprons front and back. Front and back of neckpiece have rondels of white, blue and white and red beads. Figure has twisted fibre black "hair" and a beaded hair ornament. It wears many strands of bead necklaces and yellow bead armbands, blue and white bead anklets, a 5mm white belt.
