

CARVED RHINOCEROS-HORN

The horn, of the large Indian species, in its natural shape, is carved all around with seventeen animals among which a rhino and a giraffe are prominent. Many live specimens of giraffes were imported from East Africa to China in the course of the fifteenth century.
