

# POTTERY STOVE MODELS

Buried with the dead in the belief that they should be able to continue preparation of food in the other world. Coated with green glazes which are partially dissolved into a silvery or gold iridescence. The stoves are provided with two or three cooking-holes, and the utensils and articles of food used in the kitchen, such as fish, fowl, pokers, mats, trays, ladles, vessels, and others, are molded on them in relief.

In front of the stove No. 118192 there are two reliefs—one showing a man chopping wood with an ax and another showing a cook kneeling in front of a jar.
