Description: Ewe and lamb lying in a winnowing basket. Very large hole for cord between ewe and lamb, big enough for rawhide thong, suggest a Mongol origin. Small hole later bored thru back of basket to pass smaller cord in Chinese or Manchu fashion. Acquired in Jade Market, Peking, late 1920's, early 1930's.
