**Description:** A flattish, tubular bamboo with five holes about 3.5 cm. apart, with the first hole 3.0cm. from the distal end. A similar hole is located in the back, midway between the two ends. A U is cut out of the rim of the mouthpiece. The opposite end, which is notched on one side is perforated in the center by a hole 0.5 cm. in diameter. Made by men.

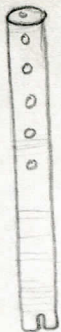
