The pan-pipe is one of the most widely distributed of musical instruments. A number of sections of reed or bamboo of different lengths are joined together. The breath is blown across the tops, each pipe producing a different tone. The specimens here shown are small and of a slight range, five notes. Better types are found in Melanesia, Eastern Europe and other localities.
