Whistles with several tones are made from the leg-bone of a deer. Several finger-stops are made at equal intervals in the hollow bone and a whistle mouth-opening is made at one end with the ehlp of pitch. Cords or strings are generally attached and the whole instrument is sometimes delicately decorated with incised designs.
