Description: A: Reeds are tied together with twine to form two flat surfaces. Three wood dowels are tied at each end with one in the middle of the reeds, sandwich fashion. Flat, notched wooden slats are tied to the short sides. A flat wooden paddle notched at either end is tied to one side. B: envelope containing seeds and stones which belong between reed layers.

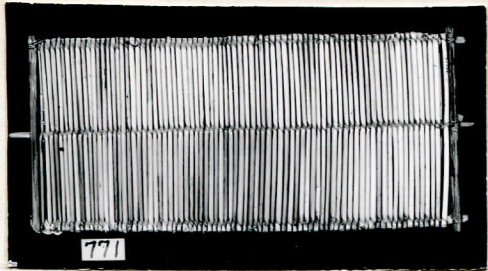
