One end is covered with monitor lizard skin, soaked and stretched over the opening then pegged. Later mended with nails. One end is of dressed cow hide also stretched and pegged and has a small hole in the center. Each end is wrapped with twisted sisal fibre cord to which is tied a raw hide sling to be worn around the hips. Used at all dances.**Dimensions:**
