on side of barrel and lug at side of lid-cap.  
15 cross bow darts made of raffia splints and  
vaned with triangular pieces of leaf.Dimensions: A- Diam.: 10.9; height: 30.1.  
(in cm.) B- Diam.: 13.8; height: 6.9.  
C-Q - Ave. Length: 19.7.
