Material: Bark, wood, cane, raffia palm mid-rib  
splints, leaves, animal hide, string

Description:

A- Wide strip of bark folded over itself and  
sewn together with strips of cane; the same done  
for the lid; wood bottom and wooden cap on<sup>B</sup>-lid;  
wad of gum on inside of lid; animal hide carrying  
strap passing through lugs on side of barrel and  
lugs at sides of lid; <sup>C-EE</sup>29 unvaned darts; <sup>FF-LJ</sup>5 vaned  
darts; <sup>KK-PP</sup>6 pieces of the leaf used in vaning; <sup>MM</sup>1 piece  
copper foil; <sup>RR</sup>1 coil of twine.
