A- Wide strip of bark folded over itself and sewn together with strips of cane; the same done for the lid; wood bottom and wooden cap on lid: wad of gum on inside of lid; animal hide carrying strap passing through lugs on side of barrel and lugs at sidesof lid; 29 unvaned darts; 5 vaned darts; Kepp pieces of the leaf used in vaning; I piece copper foil; I coil of twine.
