The Mixes have, in spite of their general conservatism, generally adopted European dress. Some women wear huipiles. These are of medium size and made of three lengths of unbleached muslin. Near the neck orifice are carefully embroidered geometric designs in red worsted. These follow the interstices so that the effect is that of a woven design, and is repeated on the reverse side of the cloth.
