Body shaped like half a calabash ^{or pear,} of wood covered with snake skin, & ^{directly} immediately connected with the arm, 4 strings. End of arm covered with a plaque of ivory, likewise the tops of the frets. Called hu-po 胡 拊 (Moule, p. 117).

Collection Do. hun-pu-se 浑不似 or hu-pu-se 火不思, probably a Mongol name first
