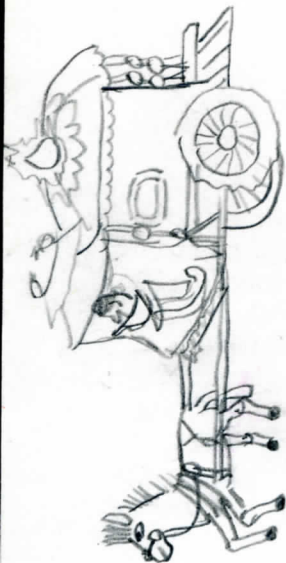
Description: Figure is of a horsecart drawn by tan horse with black eye, black, slitted mane, black hooves, hinged legs, and tan tail connected to the hindmost leg; wire handle attached to horse's ear; tan cart has a tan window in its side outlined in red, then black; wheels are tan with black dots and with black, rippled rims; top of cart is dome-shaped with red, grey, and tan ornament
