People or Culture: Sundanese *rungru (2-0)***Object:** Bonang barung* (2-octave bronze gong-chime)**Material:** Wood, bronze, oil-base, paints, pure gold-leaf, leather thongs, cotton cord, nails.**Description:** A: dark blue painted rectangular 4 legged wood stand has framework of 14 open compartments strong through with 2 long rows of doubled dark blue kerbao cord tied at the center with red cotton cord on which gongs rest. Open at back of stand with outward projecting sides at 45° angle, curvilinear floral motif in blues, gold, red. At back and front edges crested cock head carved in dark blue. (Leather and cotton replaced 1977-78). (OVER)

B: Frontispiece with carved open work curvilinear floral motif in blues gold, red and gray. C-P: 14 bronze pot gongs, bossed, flattened then gently sloping rim with slightly indented base. Original rattan cord was replaced with leather thongs in 1977-78 restoration. Played with 2 padded, thick sticks. *Name both Sundanese and Central Javanese.
