Description: Dark and lighter blue mostly ^(weave-stitch) cross-stitch, and Holbein-stitch on the whole surface of a rectangular piece of off-white cotton. Field: A variety of borders, corner triangles, filling flower-pots, insects, birds, tassels, shou-characters, scrolls, mammals; at center some riders, one of which on a possible "unicorn"; one deer. Eyes of two "lions" and stomach and reins of one riding animal are faded pink. Some rust-stains at center.
