Outer band, geometric; inner band, 6 flower-pots each with a butterfly over the flower; between the pots, ~~see~~ butterflies; at ends, swastikas. Swastikas and butterflies' antennas are made in outline-stitch. 2 holes at center and some brown stains. See #234545.
