Description: disc-shaped theatrical drum of animal hide stretched over both sides of wooden cylinder. Hide is fastened to cylinder with metal nails with large conical (shallow cones) heads. Wood cylinder is decorated with red paper. Two metal rings are fastened in the wood at opposite points on the cylinder. Sides are decorated with a painted dragon and a large bird with long ornamental tail.
