Description: Not old and with a rather poor "fill-in" of the end section. Woven in one piece on a stick-loom. Blue ground; fine cotton warp and weft two ply or used double. There are warp stripes on edges and in center; colors - black, dark green, red, and purple separated by two ends of yellow or white. Between striped areas there are bands of rather naturalistic birds and flowers along with stylized plant forms and geometric motives on both ends brocaded in bright colored plain and mercerized cotton using a double running stitch (close-spaced technique) to produce a reversible design.
