**Description:** Warp faced 2 ply cotton material. 2 white warps on side selvages, then 4 1/2 cm red warp band, then zig-zag brocading in red, lavender and mixed red and blue coarse cotton on white ground, then 5 1/2 cm red warp stripe followed by another zig-zag brocading. One end as follows from bottom: 1 cm white band, then 1 1/2 cm red weft band (barely visible), then horizontal brocaded zig-zag as down sides then 3 1/2 cm red weft band followed by horizontal zig-zag.
