Men carry wooden whistles with which they signal to each other. These are made of rectangular or oval pieces of wood and hang around the neck by means of cords. The center is hollowed out and in the base a hole is left across which the breath is blown. In the sides of the smaller specimens are finger holes which modify the tone.
