Tzendel men of Cancun wear long shirts of native woven cotton with sleeves which are open under the arms. These shirts are made of four pieces of cotton cloth stitched together with colored yarns. It is rather plain. Over this is worn a chamara of vertically striped black and white wool. They are made by the Tzotzils of Chamula.
