Description: Inverted bell-shaped candle holder tapering to short neck which widens quickly to large inverted hemispherical bowl base. 3 relief heads are set over the neck. Heads are of winged cherubs. Each head has "collar" of raised dots on base. 3 spiriliforms occur between heads. Crosshatched lines decorate base. Top of holder is punctated. Brown glaze with green zig-zags at base and other scattered splotches of green glaze decorate exterior.
