People or Culture: Ilongot.

Object: Head Decoration.

Material: Wood, brass, mother of pearl, yarn, chicken feathers, horsehair, deer hair.

Description: Stick of smooth carved wood with 4 flattened sides ending in a rounded point. A cluster of 9 black and white chicken feathers, smooth-trimmed and notched, is tied to center of the stick and are decorated along base with red and green yarn tufts and long strands of horsehair and at end with inch long tufts of red yarn. Two twisted brass wire rods are attached to blunt end of stick and are decorated with mother-of-pearl pendants
