Material: Embroidered and applied cotton

Description: One woman's white cotton jacket with shortwide sleeves. Sleeve-cuffs, round neck, and diagonal front opening have dark blue, almost black, bands of applied cotton cloth. An inner band of dark blue and white figured tape is applied between the cotton cloth band and one border of dark blue cross-stitch floral rinceau. The garment is fastened by 3 dark blue cotton frogs at the neck and 2 at the lower right side. (CS: Foreign style cloth - apparently not home-spun). Possibly unused. Some minor holes on the blue bands, as if eaten by insects.
