Material: Silk embroidered cotton

Description: Black with 2 shades of blue cross-stitch on hemmed rectangle of white cotton. Embroidered border (4.7 x 35 cm) of one band with narrow black stitch borders on either side: top, geometric zigzag; bottom, continuous circles (CS: 'ku-lu ch'ie'r', interlocking 'coin' pattern). Center band: 15 repeated compartments each with black geometric design bordered with blue and aqua stitches. (CS: Bought from Shantung embroidery boy who had them sent from his home.)
