Object: Pair of ankle-bands 山東掖縣或招遠縣

Material: Silk embroidered cotton doth

Description: Polychrome cross-stitch on hemmed rectangle of white cotton. Embroidered border (8 x 37 cm) of 3 bands of which center is largest and polychrome.

Top band: black zigzag with rosette and bird pair fillers. Center: 11 compartments each with stepped lozenge diaper framed in blue, green, & aqua. Center swastika of different color in each: 2 shades blue, yellow-green, tan, lavender, magenta, orchid. Bottom: (CS: lotus rinceau). (CS: Bought from Shantung embroidery boy who had them sent from his home.)
