Provenience: CHINA, Shan-tung, either (1) Yeh Hs., Yeh Chia-chou/119.56/37.11, or (2) Chao-yüan Hs., Chao-yüan, 120.24/37.22, near Têng-chou Fu [now Têng-chou People or Culture: Chinese (P'êng-chia) 120.45/37.49].

Object: Pair of ankle-bands 山東掖縣或拾遠縣

Material: Silk embroidered cotton

Description: Polychrome cross-stitch on hemmed rectangle of white cotton. Embroidered border (6 x 34 cm) of center polychrome band with narrow black stitch borders on either side: top, Holbein stitch in geometric pattern; bottom, (CS: alternate S-curves). Central band: 9 compartments (half compartment at each end) each with stepped lozenge diaper framed in aqua, blue & green. Peach 4-lobed figure in centers. (CS: Bought from Shantung embroidery boy who had them sent from his home.)
