Object: Pair of ankle-bands 山東掖縣或招遠縣

Material: Silk embroidered cotton

Description: Polychrome cross-stitch on hemmed rectangle of white cotton. Embroidered border (6 x 35.5 cm) of center polychrome band with narrow black stitch borders on either side: top, zigzag; bottom, geometric. Center band: 6 full compartments (2 incomplete at out-sides) with stepped lozenge diaper framed in blues and greens. Black 4-lobed figure in centers. (CS: Bought from Shantung embroidery boy who had them sent from his home.)
