Description: Polychrome cross-stitch on hemmed rectangle of white cotton. Embroidered border (5.7 x 31.5cm) of central band with narrow black stitch borders on either side: top, (CS: 'trees') in Holbein stitch; bottom, cross-stitch rincsau with pomegranate. Center band: 12 4-petalled rosettes in black, green, blue and aqua with yellow centers; interstices filled with yellow and blue swastikas in pairs. (CS: Bought from Shantung embroidery boy who had them sent from his
