Description: Polychrome cross-stitch on hemmed rectangle of white cotton. Embroidered border (6 x 34 cm) of 3 bands of which center band is polychrome and largest. Top band: (CS: triple 'tree' alternating with flower in Holbein stitch). Center: 13 4-petalled rosettes in black, blue, green, aqua with yellow centers; interstices filled with black swastikas in pairs. Bottom: (CS: rinceau with simplified pomegranates). (CS: Bought from Shantung embroidery boy who had them
