Description: Polychrome cross-stitch on hemmed rectangle of white cotton. Embroidered border (5.6 x 37 cm) of 3 bands of which center is largest and polychrome. Top band: (CS: triple 'tree' alternating with flower). Center: 14 4-petalled rosettes in black, blue, green, & aqua; interstices filled with black swastikas in pairs. Bottom band: rinceau with crabs. (CS: Bought from Shantung embroidery boy who had them sent from his home.)
